



## **2 Big Events For Johnson Volkswagen**

Reynold C. Johnson, Volkswagen distributor for Northern California, Nevada and Utah, opened a new \$300,000 office building in Burlingame on Thursday night.

The modern, two-story structure will house Johnson's executive offices, sales' and service training schools, car distribution and warranty and advertising offices. Coincidental with the opening was the arrival of the largest shipment of Volkswagens ever to arrive in the Port of San Francisco. The record load, totaling 1015 units, brings the total number of VWs that have passed through the Port since 1954 to more than 70,000.

To memorialize the occasion, Charles Hughes, director of industrial relations for the Port of San Francisco, representing the port's president. Cyril Magnin presented John with a bronzeplaque. Commenting on the two events, Johnson said: "The arrival of this record load of VWs and the formal opening of our new headquarters, signify the continuing and growing part that Volkswagen plays in our Western area.
